

BOOSTER VACCINATION PROGRAM THROUGH BCCT

The British Chamber of Commerce Thailand (BCCT) will continue working direct with the Department of Disease Control (DDC), Ministry of Public Health (MOPH) and Ministry of Foreign Affairs to provide mainly Pfizer and Astra Zeneca vaccinations, focusing primarily on booster ie third vaccinations.

BCCT is reaching out to its wider membership to invite employees of member companies to be vaccinated. In addition British nationals (particularly those over 60 years of age or with one or more of the seven illnesses stated by the MOPH), and their Thai spouses/carers are invited to pre-register on BCCT's secure database for vaccinations via this link:-

IMPORTANT NOTES:-

- Those wishing to be vaccinated must pre-register. Walk-ins are not accepted by the Thai government or vaccination centres
- Only one registration per person per one email. A registration does not cover more than one person. Couples should enter data individually.
- A registration is not transferable to another person
- The form must be fully completed as all information is required for approval by the Thai government. Successful registration generates an automatic confirmation from the system
- Booster vaccination will be Pfizer unless you state for Astra Zeneca.
- Once the appointment has been confirmed, it cannot be postponed or re-arranged
- Vaccination appointments are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Booster vaccinations can be administered 3 months or more since your second vaccination in most cases
- However, booster vaccinations can only be administered after 6 months since your second vaccination if you have had Pfizer x 2, Moderna x 2 or mixed vaccinations of Pfizer, Moderna and AZ. Please see details [Here](#)
- You may be asked to sign a consent to agree before proceeding with your booster
- If you have contracted Covid-19 you must wait 3 months before being vaccinated
- Only register if you agree with all the above notes
